What is interprofessional education?

Interprofessional Education (IPE) occurs when two or more professions learn **about, from** and **with each other** to enable effective collaboration and **improve health outcomes.**

What is collaborative practice?

Collaborative Practice (CP) occurs when **multiple health workers** from different professional backgrounds provide comprehensive services by working **with patients, their families, caregivers and communities** to deliver the **highest quality of care** across settings.

ANTHC's vision for IPE-CP

The provision of holistic care begins with the **training of providers**, transfers into their **clinical practice**, and ultimately has an impact on community and population health.

Through a model of interprofessional education and practice, Health Aides of all disciplines will **increase collaboration** on patient care which will lead to earlier identification of illnesses and risk factors, decreases in healthcare spending, and **better health outcomes for Alaska Native peoples**.

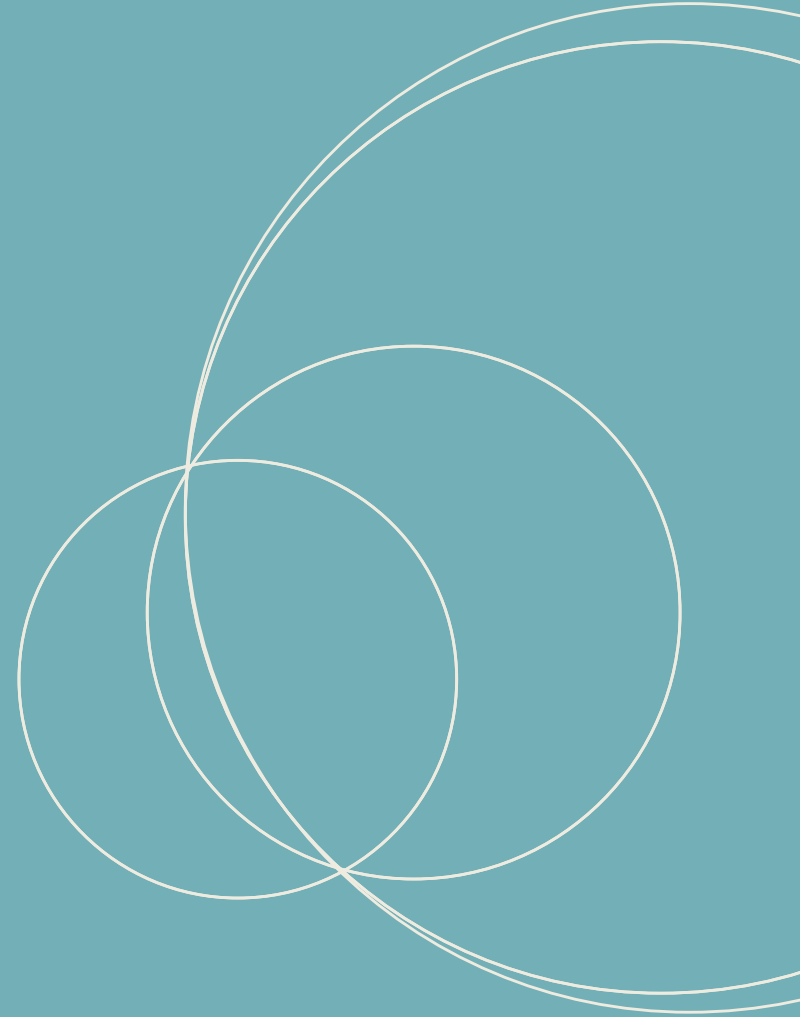
Project Overview

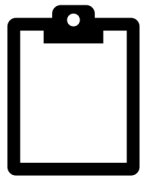

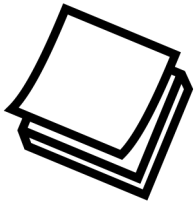
