

Alaska Community Health Aide Program  
Priority List for Basic Training

Selection priority for Basic Training slots will be based on:

1. Length of time on the statewide training needs list. (List maintained by CHAP Statewide Services). Only student names with completed prerequisites will be put onto a waiting list.
2. Student is the sole CHA provider. (No other health aides or regular/recurring other provider types)
3. Multiple CHA/provider vacancies in the clinic.
4. Student refusal to accept session invitation (at any training center) will result in student going to the bottom of wait list (circumstances beyond student control will be reviewed individually).
5. Current certification by CHAPCB.

Considerations:

Successful completion of Session I will have priority for the next Session II offered at that Training Center and are placed on waiting list. THO is still obligated to submit S-II prerequisites at 4 weeks prior to be eligible.
