To propose amendments to the *CHAPCB Standards and Procedures*, submit the following details of via email to: chapcb@anthc.org

- 1. Sponsor name and contact information.
- 2. Date of request.
- 3. Proposed effective date.
- 4. Identify the section number and current content being addressed.
- 5. Identify the location of references to the section and content for which you are proposing an amendment.
 - a. This includes references within the CHAPCB Standards and Procedures and/or forms.
- 6. Clearly outline what changes are being proposed.
 - a. Strike through and highlight in red the content to be removed. Sample removal.
 - b. Underline and highlight in yellow the content to be added. Sample addition.
- 7. Provide Rationale for the Amendments.
 - a. This section can be included at the beginning of the request or as a part of each individual amendment.
 - b. For each amendment, write a clear explanation for why the change in necessary.
 - c. The rationale should provide context, such as correcting errors, reflecting updated policies, providing clarification, etc.
 - d. You may reference CHAPCB Standards and Procedures:

Sec. 12.10.020. Consideration at More Than One Meeting. The Board shall not take action on a proposed amendment to these *Standards and Procedures* at the first meeting at which the amendment was proposed unless it first determines that:

- (a) an emergency or other exigent circumstance exists;
- (b) the amendment is necessary to correct an error in the *Standards and Procedures*;
- (C) the amendment does not have a substantive effect; or
- (d) the amendment is necessary to assure compliance with law or regulation to which tribal health programs are subject.
